Over the last 3 years, the H2020 INCENTIVE and TIME4CS projects have experimented with how Citizen Science can become a new democratic paradigm of "doing science" by supporting the institutionalisation of Citizen Science in a range of pilot Research Performing and Funding Organisations, through Citizen Science Hubs and Grounding Actions.

The scope of the Policy Roundtable is the discussion and validation of the INCENTIVE and TIME4CS projects' findings, and their potential impact on policy and policymaking at the EU level.
